GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

This fractional township is for the most part mountainous, portions of it being precipitous and impassable; the elevation ranging from about 10,000 ft. above sea level in the SW cor. to 4300 ft. along the E. bdy. on Walker Lake. The soil in the higher altitudes is rocky, while that in the lowlands is a gravelly loam, the latter under irrigation producing excellent crops of alfalfa and garden truck. The mountainous sections of the township are adaptable to grazing, while timber in abundance is available for fuel.

Water for all purposes is procured from wells, springs, and creeks. Walker Lake is considered unfit for irrigation on account of its brackish nature, there being much salt and soda in solution. Rose, Dutch, and Cottonwood Creeks, named in order from the S. boundary of the township flow in a general northeasterly direction; the waters only reaching the Lake during the freshet season, all of them sinking below the surface of the ground some distance from the edge of Lake.
