Chains

Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood and shadscale.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on S. Bdy. of Tp.
heretofore described.

N. $0^{\circ} 03'$ W., on a true line, bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over nearly level bench land, through scattering under-
growth.

6.00 Head of dry wash, course NW.

8.50 Top of low flat spur, projects NW.

22.80 Main road, from Schurz to Walker Lake, bears NW. and SE.

30.30 Dry wash, 30 lks. wide, with perpendicular banks 6 ft.
high, course NE.

31.00 Same main road, from Schurz to Walker Lake, bears N. and
SW.

31.40 NW. cor. of frame dwelling house bears E. 1.48 lks. dist.

33.63 The NW. cor. and the SW. cor. of two adjoining frame
dwelling houses bears E. 44 lks. dist.

From this point flagpole of School house bears N. 47°
 $15'$ W.

34.60 The NW. cor. and the SW. cor. of two adjoining log
dwelling houses bears E. 50 lks. dist.

36.03 The SW. cor. of frame dwelling house, bears E. 50 lks.
dist.

37.45 The SW. cor. of frame dwelling house, bears E. 36 lks. dist.

39.75 Road, bears W. From same point flagpole of School house
bears S. $74^{\circ} 45'$ W.

39.96 Proportionate distance, at which, point,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 26 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
