Chains

North, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Over rolling mountainous, asc. along broken choppy SE.  
slope, over surface covered with loose rock and through  
dense undergrowth.

5.00 Point of spur, 30 ft. above sec. cor., projects SE.; desc.  
20 ft. to

11.00 Dry wash, drains SE.; <sup>Asc.</sup> 180 ft. to

34.80 Point of spur, projects SE.; thence over nearly level  
broad point to

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 12 ins. in the
