Chains

81.40 The cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, T. 42 N., Rs. 51 and 52 E., heretofore described. This cor. on rocky NW. slope, 330 ft. above creek.
 Land, broken hilly and mountainous.
 Soil, gravelly and rocky, 2nd to 3rd rate.
 Undergrowth, sagebrush, buck brush, willows along creek, and service berry.
 Timber, none.

Subdivisions of T. 42 N., R. 51 E.

From the reestablished corner of sections 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the W. boundary of the Tp., hereinbefore described,

East, on sectional correction line, between sections 30 and 31,

Desc. 190 ft. over E. slope covered with dense undergrowth.

8.20 Water course, course S., asc. 160 ft. over broken W. slope.

18.30 Spur, slopes S., desc. 270 ft. over NE. slope.

27.30 Water course, drains NE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd:
