General Description.

The surface of the land in the portion of the township surveyed under this group consists of low rolling and broken mountains. A low divide extends in a general easterly and westerly direction through the central portion of the township. Drainage on the north side of this divide is northerly into Deep Creek thence westerly into the South Fork of the Owyhee River; drainage on the south side is southerly into the river. The only permanent stream is a small creek traversing portions of sections 25, 35 and 36. A very small intermittent stream flows northerly in the early part of the spring and summer through section 13. The above streams do not have sufficient flow to be of especial value as watering places.

The slopes for the most part are covered with a dense growth of sagebrush; some willow and scattering scrub aspen are found along the creek bottom in the southeastern
