

INVESTIGATION SURVEY, GROUP 68, NEVADA.

on East, 33 N and 6 notches on South, 34 N and 6 notches on North.

Cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 & 32. Granite rock, 6x8x14 inches mkd 5 notches East and 1 West. This corner not witnessed.

T. 33 N., R. 33 E.

Cor. of Twps. 33 & 34 N., R. 33 E. Basalt rock, 10x12x16 inches in mound of stone, mkd 34 N on NE, 34 E on SE, 33 N on SW, and 33 E on NW with 6 notches on each edge.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 1. Basalt rock, 10x12x6 inches above ground, mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face. Witnessed by pits N. and S.

Cor. of secs. 1 & 12. Basalt rock, 6x10x18 inches in mound of stone, mkd 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. sec. 12. Basalt rock, 12x15x18 inches in mound of stone, mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face.

Cor. of secs. 12 & 13. Basalt rock, 10x12x18 inches in mound of stone, mkd 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on N.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 13. Basalt rock, 6x10x15 inches in mound of stone, mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face.

Cor. of secs. 13 & 24. Basalt rock, 4x10x6 inches out of ground, mkd 3 notches on S. and 3 notches on N. Witnessed by pits in each sec.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 24. Basalt rock, 2x10x12 inches out of ground, mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face. Corner firmly set, no witness.

Cor. of secs. 24 & 25. Basalt rock, 8x12x5 inches out of ground, mkd 2 notches on S. and 4 notches on N. Faint trace of pits in each section. Very sandy soil.

Cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 & 26. Basalt rock, 8x8x24 inches in mound of stone, mkd 2 notches on S. and 1 notch on E.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 23 & 26. Basalt rock, 8x12x24 inches in mound of stone, mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 22 & 27. Granite rock, 6x8x14 inches in mound of stone, mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 27 & 28. Granite rock, 6x8x14 inches in mound of stone, mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 27 & 34. Basalt rock, 12x24x30 inches, triangular form, set in mound of stone, mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face.

Cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 & 35. Redwood stake, 5x5x18 inches out of ground, mkd T33N S26 on NE face, S35 on SE face, R33E S34 on SW face and S27 on NW face. No witnesses. From this cor., the original Dyer cor. bears S. 14° 45' W., 3.37 chains distant and is a fragment of old willow stake, with squared edges, about 12 inches in length lying on the surface of ground. No witnesses.

The original cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 & 26 is a willow stake about 18 inches in length with squared edges lying on what appears to be an old mound of earth.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 24 & 25. Original cor. is an old willow stake about 10 inches in length with one side surfaced.
