

## INVESTIGATION SURVEY, Group 69, NEVADA.

Cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36 bet. Rs. 33 and 34 E.  
Basalt rock, 4x10x10 ins. above ground, mkd 5 notches  
N. and 1 notch S., not witnessed. This cor. establish-  
ed by Deputy Maxson. in 1893.

By Deputy Criss in 1901.

Basalt rock, 12x14x24 ins. set in a mound of stone,  
mkd 5 notches N. and 1 notch S.

T. 31 N., R. 33 E.

C.C. of T. 31 N., Rs. 32 and 33 E. A fragment of an old  
stake, 12 ins. in length, 2 ins. square, with scribe  
marks distinct. A mound of earth at this point.

C.C. of secs. 5 and 6. An old stake, 30 ins. in length,  
2 ins. square, mkd. "CC" on one side, "S IV" on one side,  
"R XXXIII TXXXI SV" on one side. This corner is ap-  
parently marked for closing corner one mile east of  
this point.

$\frac{1}{4}$  Secs. 5 and 6. A fragment of old stake, 10 ins. in  
length, one side surfaced with scribe marks " $\frac{1}{4}$  S"  
very distinct. No trace of mound.

C.C. of secs. 4 and 5. An old stake, 30 ins. in length  
 $1\frac{1}{2}$  ins. square, mkd. "CC" on one side, "SV" on one  
side and "R XXXIII T XXXI S IV" on one side. No  
positive evidence of mound at this corner.

$\frac{1}{4}$  Secs. 4 and 5. An old willow stake, 15 ins. in length  
with one side surfaced and scribe marks " $\frac{1}{4}$  S" distinct.

$\frac{1}{4}$  Secs. 8 and 9. An old willow stake, 2 ft. in length,  
1 in. square, one side surfaced with scribe marks  
" $\frac{1}{4}$  S" very distinct. No trace of mound.

$\frac{1}{4}$  Secs. 9 and 16. An old willow stake, 2 ft. long,  
with one side surfaced and scribed " $\frac{1}{4}$  S". No trace  
of mound at this corner.

Cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16. An old mound of stone  
3 ft. base and about 9 ins. in height with the appear-  
ance of great age. No evidence of the wooden post at  
this point.

Cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10. The fragment of an old  
stake, 12 ins. in length and 2 ins. square on which  
scribe marks are visible; "R XX--- T X--" being very  
distinct. Several pieces of the old corner near.
