ins. in mound of stone, mkd. 5 notches E, and S. edges. Corner stone on two pieces. This corner was reported at a point about 6 chains south of its present position and diligent search was made in that locality for evidence of a second set of sorners.

1 Secs. 6 and 7. Limestone, 3x12x18 ins. in mound of stone, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face.

Cor. of secs. 6 and 7. Granite stone, 8x8x16 ins. in a mound of stone, mkd. 1 notch on N. and 5 notches on S. Careful search was made east and south of this corner for evidence of additional corner monuments.

. T. 32 N., R. 34 E.

1 Secs. 30 and 31. Redwood stake, 4x4 ins, by 2 ft. above ground scribed "1 St on N. face. Pits E. & W. Cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32. Basalt rock, 4x8x14 ins. in mound of stone, mkd. 1 notch S. and 5 notches East.

 $\frac{1}{4}$ Secs. 29 and 32. Limestone, 8x9x12 ins. out of ground mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face. The field notes record a redwood stake at this point.

Cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33. Limestone, 5x10x16 ins. in mound of stone, mkd. 1 notch S. and 4 notches E.

The object of the retracements in this investigation of surveys under Group 69, Nevada having been to ascertain the location and the relative position of the official public land corners with the view to the ultimate disposal of the public lands affected, no recommendations for remedial measures are submitted.
