Chains

- 2.00 Low spur, projects E. Desc. 44 ft.  
 23.70 Head of draw, drains E. Asc. 62 ft.  
 37.10 Spur, projects SE. Desc. 332 ft.  
 40.00 Set iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 16 ins. in  
 the ground, surrounded by mound of stone, 3 ft. base,  
 1½ ft. high, for the ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
