47.40 Road, bears E. and W.

56.20 Lexington creek, dry at this point, course E.

60.22 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

79.99 Intersect the 171st mile cor., which is a cottonwood post, 8 ft. long, 3 ins. square, marked Nev. on W. face and U on E. face, set in mound of earth. Evidence of old pits.

Alongside, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the 171st mile cor., with brass cap mkd.
