Chains. from which

✓ a pinion pine 6 ins. in dia., bears S. 76° E., 20 lks.
dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 7 B T

a pinion pine 8 ins. in dia., bears N. 68° W., 80 lks.
dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 12 B T sec.

47.00 Dry wash, 103 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ cor., course E.

51.30 Top of spur, 12 ft. above draw, bears E.
Leave heavy timber, bears N.W. and S.E.; enter scattering timber.

80.00 After diligent search failed to find any traces of old sec. cor.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 4 ins. in the ground, supported by a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 32 ins. high, for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, with brass cap mkd.
