

## SURVEY OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T.20 N., R.45 E.

## CHAINS

67.40 Draw, 165 ft. below  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor., drains S.; ascend.

80.00 On SW. slope near top of ridge, 165 ft. above draw.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T.20 N., R.45 E., with brass cap marked

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

Land, mountainous; general N. drainage.

Soil, rocky, sandy and clay of volcanic and granite formation.

Timber, scattering pinon and cedar

Undergrowth, sage and scattering yellow top brush.

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East, bet. secs. 1 and 36

Over rolling mountainous land through scattering cedar timber and undergrowth of sagebrush and yellow top. Gradually ascend.

2.50 Ridge, bears N. and S.; gradually descend.

40.00 On gentle E. slope of ridge, 240 ft. below top.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

42.00 Rye Patch Wash, drains S:30°W.; ascend.

49.00 Road, from Austin, Nevada to Indian Ranch, bears N.10°E. and S.10°W.

62.35 Ridge, 205 ft. above wash, bears NW. and SE.; descend.

73.35 Swale, 45 ft. below ridge, drains NW.; ascend.

80.00 Intersect W. bdy. of T.19 N., R.46 E., 12.85 chs. south of the cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 45 and 46 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. in dia., extending 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, and marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
