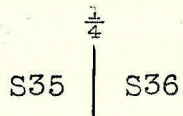

Over rolling mountainous land through dense sage and

over NW. slope 210 ft. to

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 18 ins. in
the ground on solid rock and 10 ins. in a mound of
stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



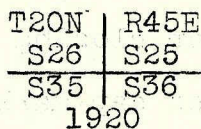
