GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

All the lands, except the N. tier of sections, in this township are mountainous in character. Parts of secs. 7, 8, 9, 11 and 12 being slightly rolling to rough. Some arable land susceptible to irrigation is found in Secs 5, 6, 7 and 87. Extensive improvements have been made by Miss Alma Woods in the above named sections, and she has about 20 acres under cultivation.
