Over rough mountainous land thru dense undergrowth and scattering timber. Asc. 620 ft. over S. slope.

15.10 Ridge, bears S.75°E., and N.75°W., desc. 240 ft. over abrupt, rocky NE. slope thru medium pinon pine and fir timber.

21.21 A northing of 40.00 chs. from the cor. of secs. 6 & 7, Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone, for 1/2 sec. cor. of sec. 6, with brass cap mkd:
