

SURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 44 N., R. 53 E.

CHAINS

From the cor. of Ts. 43 and 44 N., Rs. 53 and 54 E., previously described,

North, on true line, bet. secs. 31 and 36,


Over mountainous land thru heavy aspen timber and dense undergrowth. Desc. 80 ft. over broken NE. slope.

27.35 Draw, drains E. 10 chs. thence N.15°E., leave heavy aspen timber, bears E. and W., asc. 25 ft. over SE. slope thru scattering clumps of aspen.

32.30 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 70 ft. over N. slope.

38.10 Draw, drains NE., asc. 20 ft. over S. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone, for 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, with brass cap mkd:



*Raise mound of stone west of cor.*

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor. Asc. 60 ft. over S. slope.


45.60 Spur, slopes E., desc. 70 ft. over NE. slope.

62.60 Spur, slopes N.80°E., desc. 85 ft. over NE. slope.

69.60 Small spur, slopes NE., desc. 170 ft. over NW. slope.

78.95 Small draw, 3 lks. wide, drains NW., over gradual NW. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone, for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, mountainous; broken hilly.

Soil, gravelly and rocky; 3rd rate. Undergrowth, sagebrush, laurel, willow. Timber, aspen, scattering fir.
