



SURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 44 N., R. 53 E.

CHAINS

- 18.75 Ravine, rocky sides, 5 lks. wide, drains N.20°E., asc. abrupt, rocky SE. slope 100 ft.
- 27.60 Spur, slopes NE., desc. 110 ft. over NW. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd:



- and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor. Desc. 20 ft. along W. slope.
- 42.00 Spur, slopes NW. 10 chs., desc. 160 ft. over NW. slope.
- 58.70 Ravine, 5 lks. wide, drains W. from SE., asc. 140 ft. over steep S. slope.
- 65.35 Spur, slopes W. and NW. from SE., desc. 40 ft. over gradual N. slope.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, with brass cap mkd:



- and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
- Land, 65 chs. mountainous; 15 chs. rolling.
- Soil, gravelly and rocky, 2nd rate; gravelly loam, 2nd rate.
- Undergrowth, sagebrush, yellow top, service.
- No timber.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 16,

Over rolling and hilly land thru dense undergrowth.

Desc. gradual NW. slope 60 ft.
