

Subdivisions of T. 45 N., R. 53 E.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.
 Soil, shallow gravelly and rocky loam, basaltic formation, 3rd rate.
 Undergrowth, service berry, sagebrush, willows, manzanita sagebrush.
 Timber, aspen, scattering fir.
 Good grazing. Western exposure and drainage.

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From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., as set by me in 1920, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., extending 6 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and wit. as described by the Surveyor General.

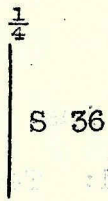
N. 0°01'W., bet. secs. 35 and 36,

Over level, cultivated field.

- 8.62 Irrigation ditch, 2 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course NE. Leave field, bears NE. and SW., asc. rocky SE. slope.
- 9.04 Irrigation ditch, 2 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course NE.
- 10.00 Small rocky spur, projects NE., 30 ft. above sec. cor. Over rolling land, draining E., thru dense sagebrush.
- 12.80 Wire fence, bears E. and W.
- 15.33 Irrigation ditch, 3 lks. wide, 1½ ft. deep, course NE.
- 16.30 Old road, bears N.60°E., and S.30°W., on top of low flat ridge, bears E. and W.

23.54 Road, bears NE. and SW.

40.00 On slight NE. slope,
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.
