dist., mkd: T16N R70E S31 SC BT

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky and gravelly; limestone formation.

Undergrowth, sage and yellow top.

Timber, aspen, fir, pine, mahogany.

Poor grazing.

SURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF TOWNSHIP 15 NORTH, RANGE 69 EAST.

From the cor. of Ts. 14 and 15 N., R. 69 E., previously described,

N. 1° 37'E., on true line as hereinbefore determined,

Asc. 110 ft. over rolling bench land sloping SW. thru scattering undergrowth.

22.20 Low spur, slopes W., desc. 10 ft. along W. slope.

23.50 Small draw, drains W., asc. 110 ft. over SW. slope.

39.96 Intersect the cor. of Ts. 14 and 15 N., R. 70 E., previously described.

Thence

North, on true line with continuous measurement,

40.01 A northing of 40.00 chs. from the SE. cor. of T. 15 N., R. 69 E.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 36, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor.

Asc. 60 ft. over S. slope.

43.60 Low spur, slopes SE., desc. slightly over E. slope.
