Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, yellow top, mountain rush.

Timber, pinon pine, cedar, mahogany.

Fair grazing.

North, on the E. bdy. of sec. 1,

Asc. rough SE. slope thru medium timber and scattering undergrowth.

33.26 Base of perpendicular limestone cliff, 100 ft. high, bears N.30°E. and S.50°W.,

34.16 Top of cliff, 620 ft. above sec. cor., bears N.30°E., to point and S.50°W., continue ascent 100 ft. over SE. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone, for ¼ sec. cor. of secs 1, with brass cap mkd:

A mahogany, 3 ins. diam., bears N.57½°W., 45 lks., dist., mkd: ¼ S 1 BT

A mahogany, 5 ins. diam., bears S.52¼°W., 101 lks., dist., mkd: ½ S 1 BT

52.40 Main ridge, bears NE. and SW., enter dense timber, same bearing., over broken SW. and W. slopes.

68.98 Intersect 3rd Std. Par. N.17.67 chs. E. of the Std. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, /previously described,

At point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for the closing
