Chains

no suitable bearing trees within reasonable distance, raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base.  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor. This cor. 80 ft. below ridge., desc. NW. slope 275 ft.

48.20 Small stream, <sup>4 lks. wide</sup> course SE., asc. 190 ft. over SE. slope. Small trail bears NE and SE.  
 80.32 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shad scale, yellow top.

Timber, mahogany, pinon pine, juniper.


Fair grazing.

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 N.  $0^{\circ} 01' W.$ , on true line, bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Asc. 785 ft. over abrupt, rocky S. slope thru scattering timber and scattering undergrowth.

21.00 Ridge, bears E. and W., enter dense timber, bears E. and W., desc. 180 ft. along NW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd;



from which

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears  $S. 84\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.$ , 44 lks.,  
 dist., mkd:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S1 BT

A white pine, 10 ins. diam., bears  $S. 28^{\circ} W.$ , 14 lks.,  
 dist., mkd:  $\frac{1}{2}$  S2 BT

Desc. 165 ft. over NW. slope thru heavily wooded area over numerous limestone outcroppings.

53.40 Draw, drains SW., asc. 430 ft. over rocky SE. slope.

69.32 Intersect the 3rd Std. Par. N., 17.57 chs. East of the Std. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, previously described,

At point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., on bedrock in a mound of stone 30 ins. high, for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd:
