

## SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 15 N., R. 69 E.

Chains

- dist., mkd:  $\frac{1}{2}$  S3 BT  
Asc. 40 ft. along W. slope.
- 43.00 Slope changes to NW., desc. 180 ft. into canyon.
- 46.40 Enter heavy timber, bears NE. and SW.
- 50.50 Creek, 10 lks. wide, course SW., asc. 130 ft. over rocky SE. slope. Leave timber, bears SW. and NE.
- 55.50 Top of rocky wall of canyon, bears NE. and SW., along E. slope.
- 61.00 Desc. slightly along E. slope.
- 69.22 Intersect 3rd Std. Par. N., 17.26 chs. E. of the Std. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, previously described.
- At point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd:

- Land, mountainous.

Timber, pinon pine, juniper, mahogany, spruce.  
Fair grazing.

- From the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of Tp., N. 0° 02' W., on true line, bet. secs. 33 and 34.  
Over rolling land, asc. 65 ft. over S. slope thru scattering undergrowth.
- 12.70 Ridge, bears NE. and S., desc. 75 ft. over NW. slope.
- 23.00 Draw, drains S. 65° E., asc. 30 ft. over SE. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, with brass cap mkd:
