

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

All the lands in this township, except portions of secs. 1, 11, 12, 9, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 27, 28, 33 and 34, are mountainous, and in many places precipitous in character. The sections above mentioned contain much land subject to cultivation with sufficient water supplied from impounding overflow from numerous springs and small creeks. Extensive improvements have been made by Joe Tognetti in secs. 15, 16, ^{21,}/~~22~~ and 28, and he has about 20 acres under cultivation, with considerable more in prospect.

That land capable of cultivation raises excellent crops of alfalfa, grain and garden truck.

The major portion of the township has a general South drainage, with a small area in the Northwest corner draining in a westerly direction.

The buildings and improvements near the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22, is known as Hicks Station.

Eureka, Nevada, the County Seat of Eureka County is located about 54 miles in a Northeasterly direction.
