 Asc. 90 ft. over mountainous SE. slope thru dense under-
 growth.

40.02 Westing of 40.00 chs., from the cor. of secs. 1 and 2,
 T. 38 N., R. 23½ E.
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in
 the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone, for ¼ sec.
 cor. of sec. 2, with brass cap mkd:

 Asc. 30 ft. over gradual S. slope thru dense undergrowth.

9.00 Spur, slopes E., desc. 30 ft. over N. slope.

19.00 Top of cliff, 40 ft. high, bears E. and W., desc. 220 ft.
