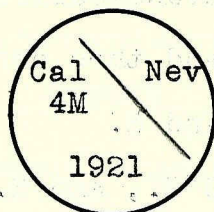


RETRACEMENT AND MONUMENTATION OF THE NEVADA-CALIFORNIA STATE BDY.

mile monument, with brass cap mkd:



Land, level.

Soil, rocky; 3rd rate.

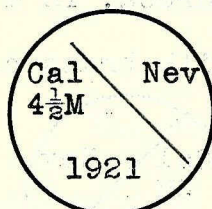
Undergrowth, salt sage.

S.46°37'E., along Nevada-California State Boundary,  
Over level desert land thru dense undergrowth,

4.90 Main travelled road, bears S.20°E., and N.20°W.

23.40 Road, bears N. and S.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 16 ins. in  
the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone, for 4 $\frac{1}{2}$   
mile monument, with brass cap mkd:



57.22 Intersect monument No. 100, which is a decayed wooden  
post, 2x2 ins., by 4 ft. high, mkd. "C | N 100" with  
shingle nails on one face, post set in mound of stone  
4 ft. base and 4 ft. high, surrounded by shallow  
trench.

Land, level.

Soil, gravelly and rocky; limestone formation 3rd rate.

Undergrowth, scrubby salt sage, sagebrush, shad scale.

From monument No. 100,

S.46°40'E., on a right line, bet. monuments Nos. 100  
and 101, along Nevada-California State Line,

Over nearly level desert land thru dense undergrowth,

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 6 ins. in  
the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone, for  $\frac{1}{2}$   
mile monument, with brass cap mkd:
