55.81 Intersect Nevada-California State boundary, 4.34 chs.

Nos. 100 and 101, previously described, in Book "B".

At point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long,
3 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a
mound of stone, for the closing cor. of sec. 13, with
