

Intersect Nevada-California State boundary, 17.23 chs.
S.46°37'E., of the 4 mile monument between monuments
Nos. 99 and 100, previously described, in Book "B"
At point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long,
2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for closing cor.
of secs. 11 and 12, with brass cap mkd:

N. of cor.

Land, level.

Soil, sandy and gravelly to rocky; 2nd to 3rd rate.


