

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

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With the exception of a portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 30, the greater part of this fractional township is level land; the general drainage being in a northeasterly direction into Walker Lake. The soil is mostly sandy loam; producing excellent crops of all garden truck and grain, when under irrigation. A scant supply of water for all purposes is obtained from Cat and House Creeks, which sink into the ground a short distance from W. boundary of the township. The water in the Lake is unfit for irrigation, on account of it's brackish nature.

F. Wallace, in secs. 17 and 20, and Emil Anderson, in sec. 18, are the only settlers cultivating land within the fractional township included in this survey.

There is no mineral deposits within this portion of the township.

Hawthorne, Nevada, the county seat of Mineral ^{County} is located in sec. 27.
