

Dependent Resurvey of a portion of the S. Bdy. of T. 4 N., R. 67 E.

Chains.

A juniper, 12 ins. in diam., bears N. $14\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 47 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S36 BT

Intersect the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, which is a juniper post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. square, with scribe marks partially obliterated, and with a small mound of earth and stone at base of post.

Alongside, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.
