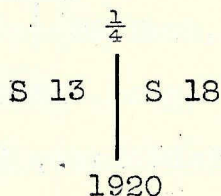

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 18, with brass cap mkd:



40.17 dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of cor., 3 ft. dist Road, bears SE. to Casey's Ranch and NW. to Broncho Springs.

115.46 Intersect the restored corner of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, previously described.

Land, level.

Soil, sandy alkaline clay, 3rd rate.

No vegetation.

From the Std. cor. of T. 36 N., Rs. 26 and 27 E., previously described,

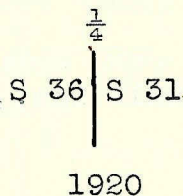
North, on true line,

Over level land thru scattering undergrowth

8.00 Asc. 310 ft. over broken SE. slope, to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

27.90 Spur, slopes SW. Asc. SW. slope,

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, with brass cap mkd:



This cor. on top of ridge, bears E. and W. Over level top of ridge

42.10 Desc. 70 ft. over broken NW. slope

52.00 Basin, extends E. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile and NW. Over gradual N. slope
