

Independent Resurvey of S. Bdy. T. 13 N., R. 25 E. 9

Chains

- Land, rough mountainous. Soil, light loose sandy and gravel on porphyry base rock, surface further covered with loose hard baked limestone cap rock. Undergrowth sagebrush and shadscale and a scant growth of grass. No timber. Copper indications were observed along this line.
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- West, on a true line, bet. secs. 6 and 31.
Over rough mountainous land, through dense undergrowth, asc. over rocky NE. slope to spur.
- 8.98 Intersect line 2-3 of Sur. No. 3144 Montgomery lode, identical with line 1-4 of Sur. No. 3141 Malachite No. 3 lode, at a point, 9.78 chs. N. $6^{\circ} 46'$ W. of cor. No. 2 and 1 of the respective lodes, which is a sawed pine post, 4 ins. sq., $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed 1-3141-M.3 on NW. and 2-3144-M on NE. faces.
- 18.18 Intersect line 3-4 of Sur. No. 3141 Malachite No. 2 lode, at a point, 7.09 chs. N. $6^{\circ} 46'$ W. of cor. No. 4, which is a sawed pine post, 4 ins. sq., $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above ground, in a mound of earth and stone, scribed 4-3141-M.2, which is on line 2-3 of Sur. No. 3141 Malachite No. 3 lode.
- 18.70 Top of spur, 294 ft. above sec. cor., projects NW.; desc.
- 27.28 Intersect line 1-2 of Sur. No. 3141 Malachite No. 2 lode identical with line 2-3 of Sur. No. 3046 Cottonwood lode, at a point 5.93 chs. N. $6^{\circ} 46'$ W., of cor. Nos. 1 and 2 of the respective lodes, which is a sawed pine post, 4 ins. sq., $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above ground, in mound of earth and stone, scribed, 1-3141-M.2 on NE., 2-3046-C on NW., and 5-3097-M-V-F. on S. faces.
- 34.50 Dry ravine, 186 ft. below top of spur, course N. 10° E.; Wagon road traverses bottom of ravine, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.; asc.
- 36.44 Intersect line 1-4 of Sur. No. 3046 Cottonwood lode, identical with line 1-2 of Sur. No. 2704 Bachelor No. 3 lode.
