General Description, of a portion of

T. 13 N., R. 25 E.

This west portion of the township contains nearly every variety of land, from level to rough mountainous, and ranges in elevation from 4400 ft. to 6000 ft. The rough mountainous land, is in the extreme S. portion, while the level land is found in the N. portion and the rolling, hilly land is located in between. Throughout the rough mountainous and rolling hilly land extensive mining is being done. Nearly the whole of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32 are private ownership by patented mining claim holdings. The soil in the mountainous and rolling hilly section is very shallow generally on a hard limestone cap rock and in many places flush with the surface
