and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, E. of cor.

Land, level and rolling. Soil, E. ½ mile, deep fine sand with clay and gravel subsoil; remaining portion, shallow sand with considerable rock near extreme W. end of line. Undergrowth, sagebrush, grease wood and rabbit brush and very little grass, rye grass in fenced field.

From the original cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.
N. 0° 14' W., on a true line, bet. secs. 25 and 26.
Over nearly level land, through dense undergrowth.

- 5.00 Enter dense willow brush, S. 60° E. and W.
- 8.20 Wire fence, bears E. and W.
- 26.00 Channel of Big Creek, 8 lks. wide, 3 ins deep, running water, course SE.
- 26.20 Leave willow brush, enter dense sagebrush, bears NW. and SE.
- 28.50 Irrigating ditch, with good running water, 5 lks. wide, 1½ ft. deep, course SE.
- 40.56 Proportionate distance, at which point,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
