General Description of

a Portion of Subdivisions of T. 37 N., R. 19 E.

The character of the land in sections 1, 2, 11 and 12,

can be classed as rough rugged mountainous table land.

Only about 50 acres at the most, along the narrow bottom of Cherry Creek in sec. 12 can be reclaimed. The table land rises abruptly from the bottom of Cherry creek to about 600 ft., and same is surrounded by small cliffs
