Soil, light sandy clay loam, medium texture, moist, mixed with loose lava rock, with numerous exposed granite ledges and outcroppings 3rd rate. Undergrowth, heavy dense sagebrush and a fine growth of nutritious grasses. Timber, scrub aspen and a few scattering pine trees.

Survey of the South Boundary of T. 44 N., R. 29 E.

From the cor. of Ts. 43 and 44 N., Rs. 28 and 29 E. set by me, East, on a random line along S. bdy. T. 44 N., R. 29 E., at

Intersect the W. bdy. of T. 44 N., R. 30 E., at a point, 17.29 chs. South of the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, which is an iron post, 2 ins. dia., 26 ins. above the ground, in a mound of stone, properly mkd. and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. At the point of intersection,
