

Retracement of the 9th St. Par. N. through a portion of R. 31 E.

Chains.

From the old St. cor. of Ts. 46 N., Rs. 31 and 32 E., which is a granite stone, 8 x 12 x 20 ins., marked 6 notches on E. and W. faces, firmly set in a mound of stone,

West, on retracement, on the S. Bdy. of sec. 36.

40.00 After diligent search, failed to find any traces of the old St. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Set temp. point.

78.09 Fall 36 lks. N. of the old St. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, which is a granite stone, 4 x 10 x 15 ins., marked 1 notch on E. face and 5 notches on W. face, firmly set in a mound of stone.

The course of this mile is S. 89° 44' W. and the distance is 78.09 chs.

From the old St. cor. of secs. 35 and 36,

West, on retracement, on the S. Bdy. of sec. 35.

40.00 After diligent search, failed to find any traces of the old St. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Set temp. point.

80.74 Fall 28 lks. N. of the old St. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, which is a granite stone, 18 x 12 x 12 ins., marked 2 notches on E. face and 4 notches on W. face, firmly set in a mound of stone.

The course of this mile is S. 89° 48' W. and the distance is 80.74 chs.

From the old St. cor. of secs. 34 and 35,

West, on retracement, on the S. Bdy. of sec. 34.

41.26 Fall 173 lks. N. of the old St. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a granite stone, 8 x 9 x 16 ins., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, firmly set in a mound of stone.

The course of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is S. 87° 36' W. and the distance is 41.30 chs.

From the old ST. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with continuous measurement, West, on retracement.

82.96 Fall 91 lks. N. of the old St. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, which is a granite stone, 22 x 18 x 10 ins., marked
