

Retracement of a portion of the W. Bdy. of T. 46 N., R. 31 E.

Chains. From the old cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, on the W. Bdy. of the township, which is a granite stone, 8 x 6 x 3 ins., above ground, marked 4 notches on S. face and 2 notches on N. face, North, on retracement, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

40.00 After diligent search, failed to find any traces of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Set temp. point.

82.93 Fall 2 lks. W. of the old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is a granite stone, 10 x 8 x 4 ins. above ground, marked 5 notches on S. face and 1 notch on N. face, firmly set in a mound of earth.

The course of this mile is N. $0^{\circ} 01'$ E. and the dist. is 82.93 chs.

From the old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, North on retracement, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

41.18 Fall 36 lks. W. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a granite stone, 14 x 8 x 6 ins., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, firmly set in a mound of stone.

The course of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is N. $0^{\circ} 30'$ E. and the distance is 41.18 chs.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with continuous measurement, North, on retracement.

82.93 Fall 43 lks. W. of the cor. of Ts. 46 and 47 N., Rs. 30 and 31 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. in dia., firmly set, and properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 47 N., R. 31 E. The course of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is N. $0^{\circ} 35'$ E. and the distance is 41.75 chs.

Dependent Resurvey of the 9th St., Par. N. through a portion of R. 31 E.

Alongside the old St. cor. of Ts. 46 N., Rs. 31 and 32 E., hereinbefore described, set an iron post, 3 ft. long. 3 ins. in dia., 20 ins. in the ground, in
