

Dependent Resurvey of a portion of the E. Bdy. of T. 46 N., R. 31 E.

Chains.

Deposit a granite stone, 8 x 5 x 3 ins., with cross marked (x) at base of post.  
 Rolling mesa land. Soil, sandy and rocky.  
 Undergrowth, good growth of sage and grass.  
 Timber: dense willows and aspen along creek bottoms; scattering aspen and a few scattering mahogany along slopes.

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 North, on a true line, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Asc. SE. slope over rough mountainous land.

3.00 Top of ridge, 10 ft. above sec. cor., bears E. and W.

Desc. N. slope over rough mountainous land, through a medium growth of aspen and scattering mahogany.

35.00 Branch of Wilder Cr., 700 ft. below ridge, running water 3 lks. wide, 2 ins. deep, course NW.
