Chains.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of sec. 34, with brass cap mkd.

S. 0° 01' E., on a true line, bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Desc. abrupt SE. slope.

14.90 Top of spur, 250 ft. below sec. cor., projects SE.

Desc. along S. slope.

38.70 South branch of Shyster Cr., 590 ft. below spur, intermittent stream of water at this point, course SW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
