

Resurvey of the Nevada-Oregon State Line

Bet. the 225th and 232nd Mile Posts.

Chains.	Asc. S.W. slope over rolling mountainous land.
19.30	Top of spur, 300 ft. above mile post, projects S. Desc. S.E. slope.
32.30	Head of wash, 20 ft. below spur, course S. Asc. S.W. slope.
49.50	Top of ridge, 160 ft. above wash, bears N.60° W. and S.60° E. Desc. N.E. slope.
67.00	Head of wash, 20 ft. below ridge, course N. Asc. S.W. slope.
80.20	Top of spur, 190 ft. above wash, projects N.
80.28	Intersect the 225th Mile Post, which is a granite stone, 8 x 10 x 20 ins. above ground, firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. 225 M and N on S. face, 42 L and O on N. face. Land, rolling mountainous. Soil, sandy and rocky. Undergrowth, bunch grass and sage.
Retracement of the S. Bdy. of T. 47 N., R. 31 E.	
From the cor. of Ts. 46 and 47 N., Rs. 30 and 31 E., hereinafter described, East, on retracement, bet. secs. 6 and 31.	
39.37	After diligent search failed to find any traces of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Set temp. point.
83.73	Fall 37 lks. S. of the old cor. of secs. 5 and 6, 31 and 32, hereinafter described. The true course of this mile is N.89° 45' E. and the distance is 83.73 chs.
From the old cor. of secs. 5 and 6, 31 and 32, East, on retracement, bet. secs. 5 and 32.	
40.00	After diligent search failed to find any traces of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Set temp. point.
82.69	Fall 207 lks. N. of the old cor. of secs. 4 and 5, 32 and 33, hereinafter described.
