General Description of T. 47 N., R. 31 E.

The character of the land of the fractional portion of T. 47 N., R. 31 E., completed under this group, can be classed as rolling mountainous and mountainous land. The elevation above sea level varies from about 5000 ft. in the west and central part of this township to about 7500 ft. along the east boundary and in the NE. corner of this township. The general drainage in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ and NW. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the township is northwesterly and is a westerly drainage in the NE. $\frac{1}{4}$. The easterly two ranges of sections contain especially rough rugged and choppy mountains with numerous small peaks, spurs and ridges having steep rocky slopes.

The soil throughout the township varies from a fine rich dark sandy clay loam mixed with rocks and gravel in
