Chains.

Desc. NW. slope.

25.00 Dry wash, 20 ft. below spur, course SW.

Asc. SW. slope 220 ft. to

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 12 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Deposit a volcanic stone, 10 x 8 x 5 ins., with cross marked (x) at base of post.

45.00 Top of spur, 20 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., projects W.

Desc. along W. slope of ridge.

69.90 Top of spur, 50 ft. below spur, projects W.

Desc. along NE. slope.

71.40 Dry wash, 160 ft. below spur, course NW.

76.99 Intersect the S. Bdy. of T. 45 N., R. 36 E., at a point, N. 88° 26' E., 3.08 chs. dist., from the cor. of secs. 32 and 33, hereinbefore described.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 20 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap mkd.

Undergrowth, medium growth of sage and scattering bunch grass.

From the cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, East, on a true line, bet. secs. 9 and 16.

Desc. gradual E. slope over slightly rolling land.
