


Survey of a portion of the subdivisions of T. 44 N., R. 36 E.

Chains.

for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



Deposit a volcanic stone, 8 x 6 x 3 ins., with cross marked (x) at base of post.

Cor. stands on SE. slope 230 ft. above sec. cor.

40.60 Top of low spur, projects SE.

45.60 Shallow wash, course SE.

Asc. SE. slope.


60.50 Top of spur, 170 ft. above wash, projects SE.

Desc. NE. slope.

78.66 Dry wash, 100 ft. below spur, course SE.

Intersect the S. Bdy. of T. 45 N., R. 36 E., at a point, N. 88° 44' E., 2.51 chs. dist., from the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, hereinbefore described.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. for secs. 3 and 4, with brass cap mkd.



Deposit a volcanic stone, 8 x 5 x 4 ins., with cross marked (x) at base of post.

Land, rolling. Soil, sandy and rocky.

Undergrowth, sage, shadscale and scattering bunch grass.

Note:-

In the preceding instances where memorials were deposited at the base of the posts, this was done because no other accessories were available - or because it was inadvisable to construct them on account of the conditions of the ground.
