


RETRACEMENT AND ESTABLISHMENT OF CORS. N. BDY. T.27 N., R.37 E.


CHAINS  
78.25 Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, S. of cor. The cor. of Tps. 27 and 28 N., Rs. 36 and 37 E., which is a 3 in. iron post, properly marked and witnessed, as described by the Surveyor General.

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF S. BOUNDARY OF T. 27 N., R. 37 E.

From the cor. of Ts. 26 and 27 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E., hereinbefore described  
Thence  
West, on S. bdy. of secs. 36  
Ascend gentle SE. slope over rolling mountainous land  
1.00 Spur, projects S. Descend W. slope 85 ft. to  
8.60 Draw, drains S. Ascend E. slope 260 ft. to  
30.00 Ridge, bears N. and SE. Descend W. slope 160 ft. to  
40.00 Unable to find any traces of old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.  
Cor. set on steep W. slope. Descend 55 ft. to  
45.80 Draw, drains S. 20° E. Ascend SE. slope 160 ft. to  
80.00 Unable to find any traces of old sec. cor.,  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, with brass cap marked



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor.  
Land, rolling mountainous. Soil, rocky and sandy.  
Timber, none. Undergrowth, sage. General drainage, S.
