

Dependent Resurvey of a portion of the 3rd Stand.

Par. S. through Range 47 East.

Chains. Land, rough mountainous. Soil, rocky and sandy. Undergrowth, scattering shadscale.

From the Stand. cor. of secs. 35 and 36,
S.88° 55' E., on a true line, on the S. bdy. of sec. 36.
Ascend abrupt N.W. slope over rough mountainous land.

24.80 Top of ridge, 410 ft. above sec. cor., bears N.20° W. and S.E.

40.94 The Stand. $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 36, herein before described. 350 ft. below ridge.

Land, rough mountainous, with numerous outcroppings of limestone and granite formation. Soil, rocky and sandy.

Undergrowth, scattering shadscale.

Independent Resurvey of the E. Bdy. of T.13 S., R.47 E.

The old cor. of T's. 13 and 14 S., R's. 47 and 48 E. is a quartzite stone, 8 x 8 x 8 ins. above ground, marked 13 S on N.E. face, 48 E on S.E. face, 14 S on S.W. face, and 47 E on N.W. face, with mound of stone S. Alongside, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of T's. 13 and 14 S., R's. 47 and 48 E., with brass cap mkd.
