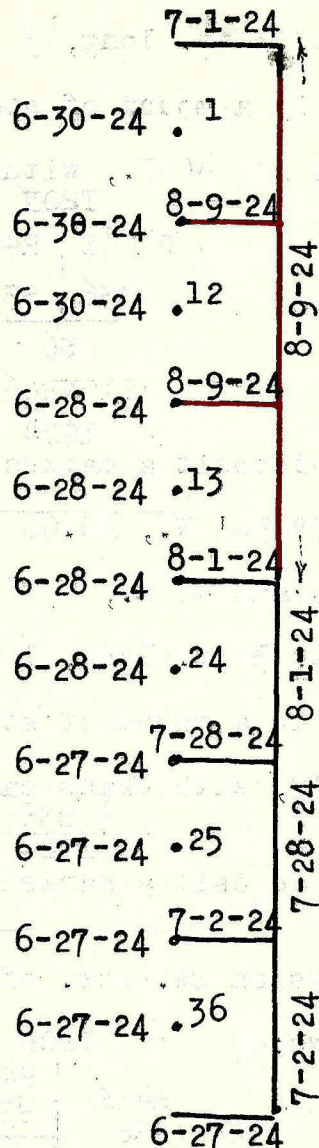


Date Diagram of T. 20 N., R. 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.

Survey commenced June 27, 1924, and executed with Young & Sons transit No. 8539, and Buff & Buff transit No. 8964, respectively used by George W. Ridgway, U. S. Cadastral Engineer and Edie S. C. Smith, U. S. Transitman, which were both approved by the Assistant Supervisor of Surveys for District No. 6, in Assignment Instructions dated July 26, 1924, subject to satisfactory field tests.

For record of instrument tests, methods of procedure and measurements used, see Book "A" under Group No. 91, containing field notes of survey of T. 20 N., R. 46 E., M. D. B. & M., Nevada, made in conjunction with the survey of this township.

Establishment of corners on S. bdy. T. 20 N., R. 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.

At a point S. 89° 58' W., 40.00 chs. from the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, Ts. 19 and 20 N., R. 46 E., which is a 1 in. iron post, set, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General, and on gentle NW. slope
