

Subdivision of T. 25 N., R. 47 E.

Chains

Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., E. and W. of cor., 3 ft. dist.

79.92 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Land, nearly level, slight E. slope.

Soil, sandy alkaline loam, 2nd rate.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood, rabbit brush.

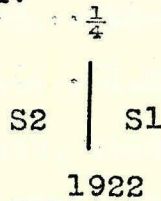
Fair grazing.

N.0°01'W., on true line, bet. secs. 1 and 2,

Over nearly level land thru dense undergrowth.

34.00 Dry wash, drains E.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd:



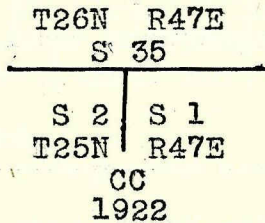
Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

48.30 Road, bears N.20°E. and S.20°W.

89.91 Intersect Fifth Std. Par. N., East 2.62 chs. distant from the Std. 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 35, T. 26 N., R. 47 E., as described in Book "A", T. 26 N., R. 47 E.

At point of intersection,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for the closing corner of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd:



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., E., S. and W. of cor., 3 ft. distant.

Land, nearly level; slight E. drainage and slope.

Soil, sandy and gravelly loam, 2nd rate.
