and S.30°E., desc. 110 ft. over broken W. slope.

80.04 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Land, broken hilly and rolling.

Soil, gravelly loam, 2nd to 3rd rate.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, yellow top, buck brush.

Timber, scattering second-growth scrub juniper on W.slope.

Fair grazing.

N.0°01'W., on true line, bet. secs. 1 and 2,

Over rolling land thru dense undergrowth and medium heavy scrub juniper.

2.00 Wash, drains S.30°W., asc. along broken S. slope on W. side of wash.

37.80 Ridge, 320 ft. above sec. cor., bears NW. and SE., desc. N. slope.

40.00 On gentle N. slope, 20 ft. below top of ridge,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd:

53.40 Draw, 90 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., drains E., asc. S. slope.

63.00 Spur, 80 ft. above draw, projects E., desc. N. slope.

68.60 Small draw, 50 ft. below spur, drains N.70°E., asc. S. slope.

80.70 Spur, 120 ft. above draw, projects N.60°E. from W., desc. 100 ft. over broken NE. slope.

88.04 Intersect the Fifth Std. Par. N., West, 91 lks. distant from the Std. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 35, hereinbefore
