

Survey of the South Boundary of T. 25 N., R. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.

Chains

From the cor. of T. 25 N., Rs. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 49 E., described in Book "D", field notes of T. 25 N., R. 49 E., Group 92, Nevada.

West, on true line, along the S. bdy. of sec. 36, R. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. Over mountainous land thru dense undergrowth. Desc. SW. slope.

9.50 Small draw, drains N.60°W., 90 ft. below cor., asc. along steep N. slope.

17.70 Point of small spur, 40 ft. above draw, projects NW., desc. along N. slope of spur, 140 ft. to

37.00 Spur, projects N.75°W., continue along S. slope of spur.

40.00 On gentle SE. slope,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36 only, with brass cap mkd:

$\frac{1}{4}$ S 36

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Continue along S. slope.

49.60 Same spur, 40 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., projects S.60°W. from N.60°E., desc. abrupt, rocky NW. slope.

69.10 Main draw, 270 ft. below spur, drains S.70°W., asc. along broken S. slope.

78.62 Intersect the E. bdy. of T. 25 N., R. 48 E., South, 4.75 chs. distant from the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, described in Book "C", field notes of T. 25 N., R. 48 E., Group 92, Nevada.

At point of intersection, the closing corner of Ts. 24 and 25 N., R. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., as described in the survey of the East boundary of the above township.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly and rocky clay loam, 2nd to 3rd rate.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, buck brush, service berry, yellow top.

Timber, a few scattering scrub junipers and pinon pines.

Grazing, good.
