34.85 The old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, which is a juniper stake, 2 ins. square, 3 ft. long, lying on surface of the ground, bears West, 11 lks. distant. No means of identifying the exact corner point by pits or other witnesses at this point. I destroy stake.

Continue over gentle rolling E. slope.
